

Elementary Classroom Supply Lists 2011-2012

Kindergarten

All supplies will be for classroom use, no names should be put on anything

All children should bring:

- Box of pencils
- Washable markers
- Box of 24 crayons
- 4-pack of Black FINE dry erase markers
- Glue Sticks
- Liquid glue
- Colored pencils
- Box of Kleenex

Suggested donations:

- Post-it notes (various sizes)
- Ziplock bags – sandwich, quart and gallon size
- Clorox or Lysol wipes
- Dry Erase markers & erasers
- Construction paper, all sizes and colors
- White cardstock

1st Grade

*Please label these items with your child's name, as they will be kept in your child's desk:

- Scissors labeled with name
- 1 box of 24 crayons labeled with name
- 1 small pencil box with name (to hold crayons, pencils, scissors)
- Little pink erasers (or other color of your choice!)

*Please do not label these items with your child's name, as they will be used as needed in the classroom:

- 1 package of 10-12 pencils
- 1 box of water colors with paint brush (found at dollar store)
- 1 package construction paper
- 1 pair of new socks (used to erase dry-erase boards)
- 2 bottles of glue
- 4 or more glue sticks
- 1 package of multicolored dry erase markers
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container hand sanitizer
- 1 container of Lysol or Clorox wipes (generic brand is ok too!)

2nd Grade

- 5 Dry Erase Markers (Expo)
- 50 pencils
- Box of Tissues
- Clorox/Lysol Wipes
- Pencil Box
- Box of Crayons
- 2 Spiral Notebooks
- 3 Pocket Folders
- 1/2 inch binder
- Subject dividers/tabs
- Glue Sticks
- Scissors

Suggested Donations:

- 1 pack of plain white copy paper

3rd Grade

3 dozen or more pencils, sharpened if possible, that would be shared by all students

A box of 24 crayons (except for Zimmerman's class)

1 box of washable markers

3 or more white board markers to share with the class

Scissors

1 package of two large glue sticks

1 ruler, with metric and customary measurements on it

1 large box of tissues

A standard-sized pencil box

Bogenschutz's students also need: 2-3 inch 3 ring binders

Zimmerman's students also need: 1 inch 3 ring binder

Cutler's students also need: 1 inch 3 ring binder

- 3 ring white binder with a 2 inch spine (Mrs. Mautner's class)
- Subject dividers (Mrs. Mautner's class)
- Liquid glue
- Markers, colored pencils, OR crayons
- Pencil box
- Protractor
- 2 composition books with lined paper
- 6-8 dry erase markers for student use
- 3 packs wide ruled filler paper
- Erasers
- 2 mechanical pencils with graphite refills
- 1 pack of multi colored construction paper

- 1 (24) pack of colored pencils
